A LOOK AT THE LEARNING...



MATH- This month we will continue to work on mastering place value to 1,000. Students should be able to identify any digit in the hundreds, tens, or ones place. Students should also be able to write any number up to 1,000 using all 4 number forms (standard form-digits, word form, expanded form, and base ten- blocks/drawing). They will have their final assessment in 3 weeks.

Following place value, students will begin to learn about regrouping with a focus on addition initially. In 2nd grade, regrouping standards will require students to add up to four 2-digit numbers as well as adding two 3-digit numbers. Mastery of basic addition facts (within 20) is especially essential going forward, so please work with your child on these at home!

ELA- During our English Language Arts block; students practice reading, writing, and spelling. Our stories this month are: *Wilson Sat Alone*, *The Enormous Turnip*, *Mr. Putter and Tabby*, *Hedgehog Bakes a Cake*, and *Lemonade for Sale*. The skill focus area's for the month of October will be: story elements, sequencing, compare and contrast, & problem/solution (plot). We will also continue to work on "opinion" writing. New spelling lists are given every Monday and listed on the weekly HW.
